I would rather contact your references directly with a few specific questions rather than have you burden them with a request to write a long letter. Moreover, the template on the web is cumbersome.

Although it is fine to do so, there is no need to make a formal application to the Clemson University Graduate School right away. After we get to know each other a little, I will give you some tips on the application process.
